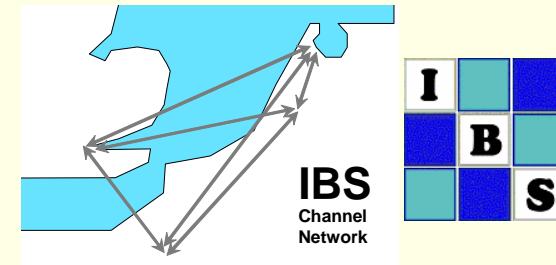
Rolduc Conference Centre is located in Limburg in the south of Holland, very close to the German border. The imposing abbey of Rolduc was founded in 1104.
